# JOINT DESIGN

OF «COOPERATION PLANS»

**From March 2023 to May 2023,** the first stage is assigned to project partner's representatives, gathered in a steering committee. The process goes through identification of situations on both sides of the border, definition and planning of actions, building **transnational teams** of professionnals.

### «COOPERATION PLANS» IMPLEMENTATION

The second stage is running from **May 2023 to the end of May 2024**. Implementation stage could involve labour inspectors, liaison offices, other public authorities (social security, tax admi-nistration) and social partners.
