  - OSH authorisation
  - daily labourers
  - labour documents archive
- Industrial relation

# Romanian Labour Inspection: Posting of workers attributions

- **Control** of the posting situations (in and out)
- **Receiving, communications** from employers service providers on the posting of workers
- Liaison office exchange of information with the competent authorities concerning posting of workers (including *IMI system*)






# Romanian Labour Inspection: Posting of workers situations

- How many posted workers?
  -45.937 A1 portable certificates issued in 2015
- improving the **information** regarding postings from Romania (employee registry *RGES*)
- complains received from posted workers
- control situations





### Romanian Labour Inspection: information requested by IMI system








### Dir. 2014/67 transposition process in Romania

- administrative procedure already enforced (prior declaration, providing documents regarding labour relation and designating a representative)
- **draft law** transposing *Directive 2014/67/EU* completed by the *Ministry of Labour, Family, Social Protection and Elderly,* was approved by the *Government* and it is on parliamentary procedure
- **new law** transposing *Directive 96/71/CE*, *Directive 2014/67/EU* as a general framework for posting of workers





#### Posting of workers new developments









- social partners
  - strengthen European level organisation
  - representativeness principle
- authorities
  - further actions based on general framework
  - two ways information exchange and one single aproach
- policy-lawmakers
  - infinite national levels vs. one single base level
